UPDATE AND NOTES FROM THE MAY MEETING

The May meeting of Tampa Bay Presbytery at First, Brandon, included the following decisions and discernments:

- Faith, Seminole, was dismissed to the Evangelical Presbyterian Church along with their two pastors, pending completion of necessary documents and the approved settlement
- Commissioned seven people to serve us at General Assembly and invited continued prayer for them: Nicole Abdnour, Adam Balic, Ella Banton, Joy Laughridge, Bill Trautwein, Carl vom Eigen, and Ivy Hussung (YAAD)
- Asked the AC for 4704 Kelly Road to meet with the congregation at Chapel in the Pines, and approved a special Presbytery meeting for Thursday, June 26, at First, Lakeland, to make a decision as a Presbytery
- Granted honorably retired status to the Reverend Cecelia Wilhite
- Approved candidate David Bonema for ordination to the ministry of word and sacrament and teaching elder in the Presbyterian Church (USA)
- Agreed to a Stated Meeting of the Presbytery on August 28 and another on November 20
- Heard that the candidate for Presbytery Coach and Coordinator had withdrawn his name from consideration for the position
