A Word From the Clerk

As those of you who were at our last Stated Meeting (or read the summary) know, our Presbytery recently elected a new Stated Clerk and Director of Communications, Rev. David Baker. I want to take a moment and tell you a little more about him (me), and the goals of this position.

I've been a pastor in this Presbytery for almost 7 years, and in ministry for more than 13. In that time I've been at large churches and small churches, done church planting, redevelopment and started a couple of online businesses. I'd like to use those experiences to help strengthen the leaders in this Presbytery so that all of our churches are making new and mature disciples of Christ.

Notice some familiar language there? One of the primary things I'll be doing is trying to help us live into the vision that we agreed to in the [Transformation Team's Report](#): to identify and strengthen leaders so that every congregation makes new and mature disciples for Jesus Christ.

As Director of Communications, my job is to remind you of this vision. Which I will be doing - *a lot*.

So much so that you're probably going to get sick of hearing it.

But if we want to live into our vision of helping each other do ministry, of being more relational and horizontal, of being the Church for one another, we're going to have to bring that intention with us everywhere we go. We didn't just agree to

change the structure of our committees and staff; it's a new way of relating to each other. This needs to become part of every Presbytery related meeting.

So what's in store for the future?

We're going to be redesigning the website. We'll be exploring new options for communication and sharing ministry with one another. This newsletter will probably develop into something significantly different than what it is currently. We'll develop new ways of learning from each other and supporting one another. But *everything* that we do will be in service to that greater vision: it's all about Christ's Church, and strengthening her leaders, both lay and ordained, so that we see more and more mature disciples.
