I once had a member of our youth group ask me, "what do you *do*?", implying that as a pastor I only did anything useful for about an hour a week, as far as she could tell.

While there's a little bit more to it, if I'm being honest a lot of what I did at the time was go to meetings. Meetings for mission, meetings for studying the Bible, meetings for planning a new contemporary service, meetings to talk about how all of our other meetings went. As a Presbyterian, there are a *lot* of meetings!

One of the biggest frustrations with meetings, particularly around the new year when you're getting new committee members or starting new committees, is finding a time when everyone can meet. I find this particularly important when you're trying to involve younger people or people who work (other than pastors, of course).

To help strengthen your ministry in this area, I'd like to share a great resource with you: <u>Doodle.com</u>.

Doodle is a meeting planning tool that you can use for free, without even needing to sign up for an account. Basically you create a poll with time and date options for a particular meeting and then email the link to your team members. This simplifies setting the meeting time significantly, and you can even create public polls that allow anyone with the link to participate! This is great if you're trying to

involve new people.
