Rev. Billy Sunday to Preach at FPC Haines City



On Sunday, February 28 the <u>First Presbyterian Church of Haines City</u> will have an old-fashioned Gospel service featuring Steve Feinberg imitating the fiery early 20th century evangelist, Billy Sunday. Billy Sunday was the precursor to Dr. Billy Graham. Feinberg, from Topanga, CA, travels the country helping congregations understand what church life and American culture was like in the early 1900s. The service will feature old-fashioned Gospel music led by FPC's choir and music director, Michael Smith. The service begins at 6:30 pm at 104 Scenic Highway (Hwy 544) in Haines City.
