

I'm going to be sort of low-tech today and do something I've never done in this space before - recommend a *book!*

Our Mission Statement as a Presbytery is to identify and strengthen leaders, but not for no purpose. The focus on leaders is so that every congregation can be making new and more mature disciples for Christ.

If you're getting this newsletter, you're a leader, and so I'm going to recommend a book to you that I've personally found helpful in making new disciples:



The main message behind this book is that guests make their minds up about coming back to your church not so much based on the sermon or the choir, but on how welcome they're made to feel when they visit. This is really important, but something that often gets less attention than the service.

We're at one of those times of the year where there will be a lot of new guests coming in at the start of school, so now is a good time to take a look at this area. You can literally buy this book for \$0.01 on amazon (click on the book cover above), so I'd encourage you to check it out. You may also want to read <u>Beyond the First Visit</u>, which is covers the same problems, but in a more "classic church" style.

If you're interested in more information like this, I'd recommend checking out the "Be the Light" conference coming to the Tradewinds in St. Pete August 8-11th. The commuting rates are very reasonable, and there are scholarships available (see below).

There will also be a day long "mini conference" on September 28th just for our Presbytery concerning church communications (print materials, websites, social media, etc).
