The Honorary Life Membership program was established in the Presbyterian Church to honor faithful service to our women's organization and to the church. More than a thousand women (and a few men) receive this honor each year. A membership into this elite group of Presbyterian Women is given in recognition of faithful service where she is involved in some area of the church's work. An honorary life membership pin and personalized certificate are bestowed on the individual who is chosen by your PW officers to receive this award.

The symbols represented on the pin signify the caring, supportive hands who seek to build a more inclusive, caring community of Presbyterian Women. The leaf represents the growth of our personal and corporate response to Jesus Christ as we nurture our faith. The dove indicates our work for peace in our own lives and throughout the world, which is represented by the globe. At the center of the design is the cross, by which our sins are forgiven, and we are freed to live in Christ, the center of our lives. The overall design – a butterfly – is a symbol of newness in Christ.

Funds derived from the Honorary Life
Memberships support the PW Leadership
Development Grant Program. Grants from this
program enable individuals to engage in
leadership development opportunities such as
the Churchwide Gathering, Ecumenical
Advocacy Days and the UN Commission on
the Status of Women. The funds also provide
for PW Gathering scholarships.

The PW group submitting a name for Honorary Life Membership will need to send a

completed form, along with a check for the correct amount to the treasurer for PW in their presbytery, who will forward this information/check on to the national headquarters. This process generally takes about six weeks, so we encourage you to plan ahead and consider when your group wants to give this deserving honor to the individual prior to the presentation date.
