OUR LOCATION:

Peace Memorial Presbyterian Church (110 S. Fort Harrison Ave.) is located at the northwest corner of Ft. Harrison Avenue and Pierce Street in downtown Clearwater.

During peak traffic times, you may use Park Street or Pierce Street via Myrtle Avenue.



PARKING:

Ample parking is available behind and across the street from the church. There are four areas to park:

- * In front of the church (east side) directly across Fort Harrison Avenue—this larger lot has entrances via Pierce Street or Park Street.
- * Behind the church (west side).
- * Just to the north of the church—this parking is open to non-county employees on evenings and weekends only.
- * In the City Hall lot to the west.

RAMP ACCESS:


There is a wheelchair/stroller accessible entrance, as well as designated parking, in the parking lot behind (west) of the church.
