Please Pray . . .

Our partners in **Africa** and **Latin America** ask us to prayer for the following situations:

- * Madagascar held the second round of its presidential elections in December, a run-off between former President (and former Vice President of the FJKM) Marc Ravalomanana and former head of the "transitional authority" installed by the military in 2009, Andry Rajoelina. The High Constitutional Court validated the Independent Electoral Commission's finding that Rajoelina had won by 56% to 44%. Rajoelina was inaugurated on Jan. 19.
- * A 150% increase in the fuel price in **Zimbabwe** (to about \$12.53 per gallon) touched off massive demonstrations in major urban areas of the country, leading to harsh response from the security forces. Roughly a dozen people were killed and hundreds injured in the ensuing protests. The main labor federation called for a nationwide stay-at-home. The fuel price hike comes on top of severe shortages of basic commodities and high inflation, which has raised concerns about a return to the hyperinflation of a decade ago. Please pray for the people of Zimbabwe who are struggling to make ends meet and for pastors who are ministering to communities in pain.
- * Disturbances and manifestations in **Venezuela** are increasing. Deaths are reported as result of this unrest.
- * Continue praying for the political situation in **Nicaragua** and the economic situation in **Cuba**.
