Search Team Strategies to Identify New Talent and to Nurture Younger Women

The Search Team of your PW Coordinating Team has an important responsibility which affects the future of your PW: it identifies and invites candidates to accept positions on the coordinating team. Pray regularly for this team and its work.

Refer to page 21 of the new PW Manual to review job descriptions for the search team and search team moderator, and review the bylaws/standing rules of your PW Presbytery and your local congregation PW.

Throughout the year make a commitment to attend as many presbytery-wide (or local congregation-wide) events as possible, and get to know the attendees. Make notes of any memorable things about the women with whom you speak. Use your own observations at these events and from previous years' events to create a group of possibilities for current and future nominees.

Make a chart listing the positions and next to each one, list key qualities, abilities, and activities essential to being an effective leader in that capacity. Try to identify two or three women per position whom you would like to consider. You know those women who would be perfect for a certain position and are so busy that no one wants to ask them to serve in one more position? Ask them! Give them the opportunity to make that decision for themselves, rather than your search team making the decision for them. Approach each candidate with love, compassion, and excitement for the position in which you are asking her to serve.
